PRESENTATION

The Château de la Vieille Chapelle is a 12th century Romanesque chapel in the middle of 21 hectares of land, including a 7.12 hectares vineyard directly bordering the Dordogne and located in the town of Lugon and the Île du Carney.

Certified organic farming since 2013.
Certified biodynamic farming since 2017.

The cuvée "Tradition" is a straight and well-balanced Bordeaux, very supple, with nice ripe red fruits aromas.



TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Soils: argilo-limoneux

Grape varieties:

- Merlot
- Cabernet Franc

Age of the vineyard: 60 years

Yield: 40 hl / ha

Density: 5 500 plants / hectare

Vinification:

- Manual harvest and parcellar selection
- Vinification in concrete tanks without epoxy coating.
- Short maceration
- Indigenous yeast
- Not aged in barrel
- Wines are not fined and not filtered
- Low sulfites
