Vineyard located on the upper slopes of the Côtes de Castillon offering a unique geological and geographical balance.

There is an exceptional variation in altitude with plots on slopes and terraces.

The growth of the vine is mastered so as to have a harvest, perhaps more modest, but of better quality.

The treatments and amendments are made with natural products to protect the environment.

TECHNICAL INFORMATIONS

OWNER : François-Thomas BON

TERROIR : Soils and basements made of maritime fossil limestone and rocky soils interspersed with clay rich in iron ore and red clay.

GRAPES PROPORTION : Merlot 100 %

AGE OF THE VINES : 25 ans

DENSITY : 5 600 à 7 000 pieds/ha

PRODUCTION : 20 000 bottles

VINIFICATION / AGING:

- Total destemming.
- Post-destemming mechanical and manual sorting.
- Cold pre-fermentation maceration of 6 to 8 days which extracts and magnifies the fruit.
- Alcoholic fermentations with indigenous yeasts at 25-26 ° C, daily tasting for optimal control and delicate extraction.
- Maceration from 28 to 30 days and gravity pressing.
- Majority aging of 12 months in French oak barrels (20% to 50% new wood depending on the vintage).
